Rockwood works to protect student information and access to appropriate resources on-line using a variety of technology systems. Additionally, Technology Department personnel annually review end-user agreements for the on-line services used by staff and students in the district. Due to changes in the end user agreements of two systems that students use in the classroom, the Children's On-Line Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) requires the Rockwood School District to ask for consent from parents of children under the age of 13 before setting up access to these systems.
